Dr. Taylor-Osborne will present ethics discussion, including case studies, to fulfill the Kansas licensing requirements. This presentation will bring to attendees information from the realm of public health, including: teledentistry, dental therapist legislation, ADA's code on diabetes screenings, HPV/oral cancer and community water fluoridation.

Cathleen Taylor-Osborne is the State Dental Director and the KDHE Director of the Bureau of Oral Health. After practicing dental hygiene for 15 years, Cathy graduated from UMKC School of Dentistry and subsequently practiced dentistry in Overland Park for 11 years. She has been continually active in organized dentistry including participation in state and local committees, professional organizations, multiple positions in the Fifth District, and serving on KS Mission of Mercy projects. In 2011, Cathy completed her MA in Bioethics and Health Policy and traveled to Bangalore, India to establish a dental clinic. She is the recipient of multiple awards including the 2016 KDA Dentist of the Year, and Kansas Dental Champion in 2015.

Mr. Anderson will discuss his investigations including Medicaid and insurance fraud, compliance programs and identity theft, and ways to protect you and your practice.

Steven Anderson is the Special Agent in Charge of the Medicaid Fraud & Abuse Division of the Kansas Attorney General's Office. His law enforcement experience includes over two years with the Medicaid Fraud & Abuse Division and over 27 years in Federal law enforcement. He served as the Special Agent in Charge of the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Labor Racketeering and Fraud Investigations, Washington Field Office. He was previously the Special Agent in Charge with the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Inspector General, and held investigator positions with the General Services Administration, OIG, and U.S. Air Force, Office of Special Investigations. He holds a Bachelor of Science in Management of Human Resources from Park University and an Associate Degree in Criminal Justice.

Dr. Dexter will discuss ethical considerations when using/not using CBCT scanning technology for complex diagnosis and treatment planning.

Fifth District member Dr. Stuart Dexter attended the University of Kansas and was awarded early acceptance at UMKC School of Dentistry. Following his graduation in 1987, Dr. Dexter completed a General Practice Residency at the VA Medical Center in Kansas City. He then completed a residency in prosthodontics and an oral and maxillofacial fellowship at M.D. Anderson Cancer Clinic in Houston. From 1991 to 1993, Dr. Dexter worked for the Canadian Health Organization treating patients who had limited access to dental care. He then returned to Kansas City where he taught at UMKC dental school as a professor of prosthodontics, before opening his private practice in 2000. Dr. Dexter is also a top speaker at the ADA convention, is a member of the Honors Dental Society, and currently teaches dental residents at the Truman Center.
